Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 18 19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 20 listed in subsection (b): 21 (B.T. 24-041, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 22 by this reference) 23 (a) Appropriated from: \$2,500,000.00 24 See B.T. 24-041 25 (b) Appropriated to: 26 See B.T. 24-041 \$2,500,000.00 27 Explanation of Appropriation: (C) 2.8 The funding above represents an appropriation 29 \$2,500,000.00 from the Northbank Riverwalk - Northbank Bulkhead project to the Southbank Bulkhead project (the 30 "Project") to provide additional funding to cover increased 31

costs of the Project due to unforeseen cost escalations.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section to transfer funds from the Northbank Riverwalk - Northbank Bulkhead project to the Project to provide additional funding for the Project. This appropriation is necessary to cover unforeseen cost escalations. This transfer is possible received to fund because а grant was the Northbank Riverwalk - Northbank Bulkhead project.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
