6 AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF AMBER
7 J. SAHBUDAK, A CLAY COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER
8 OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT COUNCIL, FILLING A
9 SEAT FORMERLY HELD BY RYAN ERTEL, PURSUANT TO
10 SECTION 80.102 (COMPOSITION; MEMBER
11 QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS; ANNUAL TRAINING
12 REQUIREMENT; RESPONSIBILITIES), CHAPTER 80
13 (PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT COUNCIL), *ORDINANCE CODE*,
14 FOR A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31,
15 2026; ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC
16 BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO
17 SECTION 50.102(B) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND
18 COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50
19 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS),
20 *ORDINANCE CODE*; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY
21 PASSAGE; WAIVING SECTION 50.102(C) (MEMBERS OF
22 BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION),
23 CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND
24 COMMISSIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS TO THE
25 REQUIREMENT THAT THE BILL SPONSOR APPEAR BEFORE
26 THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THE APPEARANCE OF
27 THE APPOINTEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **WHEREAS**, the initial grant process for the Public Service Grant
30 ("PSG") Council requires the attention and input of PSG members and
31 will begin imminently; and

1 **WHEREAS**, PSG Council members are needed to complete member
2 training, fill vacancies, appoint PSG officers and begin providing
3 their expertise to the PSG Council as expeditiously as possible; now
4 therefore

5 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby confirms the
7 Mayor's appointment of Amber J. Sahbudak, a Clay County resident, to
8 the Public Service Grant Council, filling a seat formerly held by
9 Ryan Ertel, pursuant to Section 80.102 (Composition; Member
10 Qualifications; Terms; Annual Training Requirement;
11 Responsibilities), Chapter 80 (Public Service Grant Council),
12 *Ordinance Code*, for a first full term to expire on December 31, 2026.

13 **Section 2. Establishing Substantial Economic Business**
14 **Interest in Duval County.** Section 50.102(b) (Members of boards and
15 commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of
16 Boards and Commissions), *Ordinance Code*, requires Board and
17 Commission members be either permanent residents of Duval County or
18 to maintain substantial economic business or philanthropic interest
19 as determined by the City Council within Duval County. In this
20 instance, although the appointee does not reside within Duval County,
21 Ms. Sahbudak has substantial economic business interests in Duval
22 County, serving as the President and Owner of Ocean Movers Inc.,
23 located at 8601 Youngerman Court, Unit 4 in Jacksonville and as the
24 current General Manager of Jacksonville Quartz and Stone LLC, located
25 at 8570 Philips Highway, Unit 109 in Jacksonville.

26 **Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
27 **to Council Rule 4.901 (Requesting Emergency Passage).** One cycle
28 emergency passage of this Ordinance is requested to enable the
29 appointee to participate in member training and to participate
30 meaningfully in the time-sensitive initial grant process which begins
31 imminently.

1 **Section 4. Waiver of Section 50.102(c), Ordinance Code.**

2 Section 50.102(c) (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1
3 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions),
4 *Ordinance Code*, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the bill
5 sponsor appear before the Rules Committee prior to the appearance of
6 the appointee. Because this legislation was filed requesting
7 emergency passage by the Council, there was not sufficient time during
8 the legislative process for the bill sponsor to appear prior to the
9 appointee.

10 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become

11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12 without the Mayor's signature.
