5 AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF
6 CORETTA HILL, A ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A
7 MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM
8 COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE SEVEN COMMUNITY
9 REPRESENTATIVES, REPLACING WILTON BLAKE,
10 PURSUANT TO SECTION 118.605, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR
11 A FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2026;
12 ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC BUSINESS
13 INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION
14 50.102(B) (RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT) (MEMBERS OF
15 BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION),
16 CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND
17 COMMISSIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING AN
18 EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 118.605(a), *Ordinance Code*, the
21 membership of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall
22 include one non-voting and ten voting members: a CSGP Committee
23 chairperson (non-voting), appointed by the President of the Cultural
24 Council Board of Directors; three other Cultural Council Board members
25 selected by the Board President and Committee Chairperson; and seven
26 individuals selected by the above group (Cultural Council Board
27 President, CSGP Committee chairperson, and three selected Cultural
28 Council Board members); and

29 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 118.605(d), *Ordinance Code*, all
30 members of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be
31 confirmed by the City Council; now therefore

1 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 **Section 1. Confirmation.** The Council hereby confirms the
3 appointment of Coretta Hill, a St. Johns County resident, to the
4 Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Wilton Blake, as
5 one of the seven community representatives, pursuant to Section
6 118.605, *Ordinance Code*, for a first full term expiring December 31,
7 2026.

8 **Section 2. A Non-Resident of Duval County with Substantial**
9 **Economic Business Interests in Duval County.** Section 50.102 (Members
10 of Boards and Commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50
11 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), *Ordinance Code*, requires
12 Board and Commission members be either a Duval Country resident or
13 individuals with substantial economic business interest or
14 substantial philanthropic interest in Duval County. Ms. Hill has
15 substantial economic business interests in Duval County. She is the
16 Chief Operating Officer for United Way of Northeast Florida, and
17 previously served as United Way Vice President of Volunteer and
18 Community Engagement for more than a decade. United Way of Northeast
19 Florida is in the Jessie Ball duPont Center located at 40 East Adams
20 Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.

21 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
