BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

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The funding above represents a transfer of \$2,162,000.00 from two countywide drainage system rehabilitation and underdrain replacement projects to repair seven (7) named drainage system rehabilitation and underdrain replacement projects.

7 Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to transfer funds from two countywide drainage system 8 9 rehabilitation and underdrain replacement projects to seven (7) 10 drainage system rehabilitation and underdrain replacement projects, as follows: (1) the Silver Street drainage improvement project 11 (\$25,000.00); (2) the Cain Lane & Able Street drainage project 12 (\$436,000.00); (3) the Crest Drive drainage project (\$502,000.00); 13 (4) the Old Kings Road drainage project (\$300,000.00); (5) the Sunbeam 14 15 Road drainage project (\$400,000.00); (6) the Saddle Road underdrain repair project (294,000.00); and (7) the Reedy Branch underdrain 16 repair project (\$205,000.00). 17

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Capital Improvement 18 Plan 19 Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year 20 Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its 21 independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation 22 of funds to the Projects, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated 23 24 herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral 25 of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP 26 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community 27 because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the commencement and completion of the Projects. 28

29 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of 30 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the 31 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP

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amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

5 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 7 without the Mayor's signature.
