Type of Action: Appropriation of state grant funding through the National Park Service; amendment of the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan ("CIP"); designation of an oversight department

Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$1,435,385 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation, through the National Park Service, to pay for the construction of the Timuquan Trail – Segment C along Fort Caroline Road in District 1. It amends the 2024-2028 Five-Year CIP to reflect this appropriation. It designates the Department of Public Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division as the oversight department for the project.

Background Information: This project will install a multi-use trail from Mount Pleasant Road to the termination of the road near Huguenot Lane and is part of an area-wide trail plan consisting of up to eight separate segments.

Because this Ordinance requires an amendment to the Five-Year CIP, it requires a two-thirds vote of Council members present for passage.

Policy Impact Area: Public works and trail construction

Fiscal Impact: This bill appropriates \$1,435,385 in grant funds to pay for a trail construction project.
