AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$209,984.02 FROM THE COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP - INTERSECTION PROJECT TO THE TOWNSEND ROAD SIDEWALK - SOUTH PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO PAY FOR DESIGN AND ENGINEERING COSTS RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF TOWNSEND ROAD, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-055; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THETRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:
The funding above represents an appropriation of \$209,984.02 from the Countywide Intersection Imp -

\$209,984.02 from the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection Project to the Townsend Road Sidewalk - South

Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Countywide Intersection Imp - Intersection Project to the Townsend Road Sidewalk - South Project (the "Project") for the design and engineering of the Project. The Project will entail installation of approximately 1.5 miles of sidewalk on the south side of Townsend Road. This location has a high level of pedestrian crashes and fatalities, including two (2) wheelchair crashes and two (2) fatalities, and the shoulder of the road at this location cannot be used because of deep ditches.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets, March 4, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the commencement and completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the
