**ORDINANCE 2024-249**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$179,000.00 IN AVAILABLE INTEREST REVENUE FROM THE DUVAL COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR INTEREST EARNINGS TCSG TAX COLLECTOR GENERAL OPERATIONS - FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATION 361105 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR BUILD-OUT COSTS OF THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE YATES BUILDING TO SERVE AS THE DUVAL COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR'S RECEPTION AND WAITING AREA, DROP-OFF LOCKER FOR CAR DEALERS AND TITLE SERVICE OFFICE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-067; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of funds from Tax

Collector Interest Earnings 361105 Account to the TCSG Tax  
Collector General Operations - Financial and  
Administration Account. These funds are not part of the  
City's pooled earnings. No City match is required.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
Section 1 is to provide funding for the remodeling, build-out and  
furnishing of a section of the first floor of the Yates Building,  
which is the Main Branch of the Duval County Tax Collector. This area  
on the first floor will be remodeled into a reception and waiting  
area, will provide a secure drop-off locker solution for car dealers  
and will create a Title Services Office.

**Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this  
Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-  
2025.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
without the Mayor's signature.
