AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,435,385.00 GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PAY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE TIMUQUAN TRAIL - SEGMENT C ALONG FORT CAROLINE ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-064; APPROVING AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT, FINANCIAL PROJECT NUMBERS 441861-2-58-01 AND 441861-2-68-02, BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED ORDINANCE 2023-505-E BYTO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,435,385.00 in grant funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation through the Florida Department of Transportation to the Timuquan Trail - Segment C Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate grant funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation through the Florida Department of Transportation to pay for the construction of a multi-use trail along Fort Caroline Road from Mount Pleasant Road to the termination of the road near Huguenot Lane. This project is a portion of an area-wide trail plan consisting of eight (8) separate segments.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver that certain Local Agency Program Agreement, Financial Project Numbers 441861-2-58-01 and 441861-2-68-02, between the Florida Department of Transportation and the City, substantially in the form placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference. The

City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral may result in loss of grant funds.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Oversight. The Department of Public Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division, shall oversee administration of the grant, the Project and the Agreement described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
