**ORDINANCE 2024-288**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, THROUGH ITS FY 23-24 STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU GRANTS/JACOB'S LADDER FY 23-24 PROJECT TO COMBAT ILLEGAL FENTANYL ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-090; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

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(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the

Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Jacob's Ladder  
FY 23-24 Project to combat illegal fentanyl activity. The  
grant period commenced on July 1, 2023, and continues  
through June 30, 2024. No local match is required.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
Section 1 is to utilize the Fentanyl and Opioid Eradication (FOE)  
grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement through  
its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication  
(S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct investigations designed to  
combat illegal fentanyl activity and will cover expenses related to  
overtime for such investigations. A copy of the Financial Assistance  
Agreement outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant  
and use of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and  
incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
shall oversee administration of the grant and project described  
herein.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
without the Mayor's signature.
