This request has been submitted to appropriate \$200,000 for funding for the Façade Matching Renovation Grant Program. The Facade Renovation Matching Grant. The purpose of the façade grant is to provide commercial or retail façade renovation funding assistance for existing businesses in targeted areas (economically distressed areas). The public investment in the facades of these structures can provide a value increase to obtain traditional financing for upgrades. The public investment in facade of structures can help reduce blight and create positive momentum towards community. This reappropriation will replenish program funding to allow Jacksonville business owners to make improvements to their properties and benefit their surrounding communities. The Facade Grant funding is being increased from \$5,000 to \$7,500 for properties in an Economically Distressed Area Level 1, and increased from \$10,000 to \$15,000 for properties located in Economically Distressed Area Level 2. The Office of Economic Development will continue to provide oversight for the Facade Renovation Grant Program.
