7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$400,000 FROM GENERAL
8 FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
9 FUNDING FOR THE HOME ROOF INITIATIVE DESCRIBED
10 AND APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-807-E; PROVIDING
11 FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; AMENDING
12 THE HOME ROOF INITIATIVE PROGRAM GUIDELINES
13 PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-807-E;
14 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS
15 DEPARTMENT, HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
16 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$400,000
31 from General Fund Operating Reserves to provide additional

1 funding to the Miscellaneous Grants and Aids budget for
2 the Home Roof Initiative described in and approved by
3 Ordinance 2023-807-E.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to provide additional funding for the Home Roof
6 Initiative originally approved by Ordinance 2023-807-E. This
7 Initiative was created based on recommendations from the Mayoral
8 Transition Committees and a series of community conversations as one
9 of several programs that could assist in addressing homelessness or
10 homelessness prevention in Jacksonville. This Initiative provides
11 funding in a maximum amount of up to \$14,999 to qualified households
12 in Duval County in need of a roof replacement to avoid loss of
13 insurance coverage.

14 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall
15 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

16 **Section 4. Amending the Home Roof Initiative Program**
17 **Guidelines Previously Approved by Ordinance 2023-807-E.** The Home
18 Roof Initiative Program Guidelines previously approved by Ordinance
19 2023-807-E are hereby amended to provide that bundling of individual
20 projects for procurement purposes is prohibited and to set a minimum
21 goal of 25% participation of Jacksonville Small and Emerging
22 Businesses (JSEBs) as contractors for the Home Roof Initiative. The
23 revised Program Guidelines are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
24 incorporated herein by this reference.

25 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Neighborhoods Department,
26 Housing and Community Development Division, shall have oversight of
27 the project described herein.

28 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
30 without the Mayor's signature.
