A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING DUVAL TEACHERS UNITED ON ITS 50 YEAR HISTORY OF SUPPORTING AND ADVOCATING FOR TEACHERS. PARAPROFESSIONALS, OFFICE PERSONNEL AND SECURITY GUARDS WORKING IN DUVAL COUNTY PUBLIC REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE SCHOOLS; INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Duval Teachers United was formed in 1974 during a period of upheaval and contention about the funding and administration of public education in Florida following the statewide teachers strike in February and March of 1968; and

WHEREAS, Duval Teachers United resulted from a series of negotiations between competing teacher unions and produced a single organization to represent teachers in their negotiations with Duval County Public Schools on matters including compensation, benefits and working conditions in schools; and

WHEREAS, in subsequent years the union expanded its membership to include paraprofessionals, office employees and security guards as well as teachers and now represents the collective interests of the vast majority of school personnel in the district; and

WHEREAS, Duval Teachers United has long advocated for recognition of the professionalism and dignity of education professionals and has created avenues for in-service professional development of its members utilizing the latest in proven research along with workshops and conferences featuring leaders in the field of education research; and

WHEREAS, DTU and its compatriots in other counties vigorously advocate for the needs of the public education system at the state level before the Florida Legislature, the Governor, and the Florida Department of Education to ensure that the needs of students, families, teachers and communities are understood, respected and appropriately funded to support the vitally important mission of public education in the state; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Duval Teachers United on its 50-year history of successful representation of the interests of its membership in the collective bargaining process and its strong commitment to advocacy and publicity for the importance of a high-quality public education system in Florida. As advocates for the dignity and importance of the teaching profession, DTU performs a valuable service in the education of Florida's next generation of citizens and leaders and the City Council commends the organization's members and leaders for their important work.

Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the City Council wishes to extends its congratulations to the organization on its 50th anniversary which will occur on May 8, 2024 prior to the next available City Council meeting.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
