A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING AND REQUESTING THE MAYOR TO CONDUCT A COUNTY-WIDE ASSESSMENT TO OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMPROVEMENTS, STUDIES OR NEEDS ASSESSMENTS, AND OTHER INITIATIVES AIMED AT ADDRESSING BLIGHT, INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, REVITALIZATION, REHABILITATION AND REDEVELOPMENT ΙN ECONOMICALLY DISTRESSED COMMUNITIES AND THROUGHGOUT NEIGHBORHOODS THECITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WOODLAND ACRES, MIXON TOWN/LACKAWANNA AND MAGNOLIA GARDENS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR APPROPRIATE FUNDING IN THE PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO PAY FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, STUDIES OR NEEDS ASSESSMENTS, AND OTHER INITIATIVES IDENTIFIED THROUGH THE ASSESSMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

the City Council recently discussed the need and desire to undertake a county-wide assessment of the City's most economically distressed communities and neighborhoods to identify opportunities for revitalization and improvement of these areas; and WHEREAS, the Council recognizes this type of assessment is a significant effort that would require coordination between the Mayor and her Administration and the City Council to identify the true needs of these communities and to propose effective and appropriate

solutions that address blight, infrastructure needs, and opportunities for capital improvements and revitalization of these important and historic neighborhoods of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interests of the City to initiate this assessment in conjunction with the Administration's preparation of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget for the City of Jacksonville with the hope that appropriate funding can be included in the proposed budget; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Encouraging the Mayor to Conduct a County-wide Assessment of Economically Distressed Areas of the City and to Provide for Appropriate Funding in the Proposed FY 2024-2025 Budget to Address Identified Needs. The Council hereby encourages and requests the Mayor to conduct a county-wide assessment to identify opportunities for capital improvements, studies or needs assessments, and other programs and initiatives aimed at addressing blight, infrastructure improvements, revitalization, rehabilitation and redevelopment of economically distressed communities and neighborhoods throughout the City of Jacksonville. This assessment should specifically include, but is not limited to, the Woodland Acres, Mixon Town/Lackawanna and Magnolia Gardens neighborhoods. Furthermore, the Council requests the Mayor to include appropriate funding in the proposed Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget of the City of Jacksonville to pay for capital improvements, studies or needs assessments, and other initiatives identified through the county-wide assessment.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
