These two tasks will empower Jacksonville, Baldwin, Atlantic Beach, Neptune Beach, and Jacksonville Beach to identify in a data-driven and geographically standardized way the level of risk septic systems may be facing in their jurisdictions, and to create septic-to-sewer conversion project groupings that are financially and spatially efficient and are most likely to reduce septic system risk failure.
