Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 22 listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 24-093, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 23 24 by this reference) 25 (a) Appropriated from: \$1,500,000.00 See B.T. 24-093 26 27 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 24-093 \$1,500,000.00 2.8 29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation: 30 The funding above represents an appropriation \$1,500,000.00 from the project titled Broward Road Widening 31

to the project titled Broward Road Improvements ("Project") to provide funding to construct the Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to allocate funds from the project titled Broward Road Widening to the Project. These funds were erroneously placed in the Broward Road Widening project and this appropriation corrects that error. The Project includes replacement of several sections of Broward Road that are experiencing pavement failure due to settlement of the poor material below Broward Road, which will increase driver safety and safeguard against costly repairs in the future.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to appropriate funds to the Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall have oversight in the projects described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
