As we highlight the beauty, diversity, 16 17 and attractions that Jacksonville has to offer, let us also recognize the positive impact of tourism on local businesses, job creation, and 18 overall economic vitality; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the travel industry also supports the interests of 21 Jacksonville, contributing to our employment, economic prosperity, 22 international trade and relations, peace, understanding and goodwill; 23 and 24 WHEREAS, travel ranks as one of Jacksonville's largest 25 industries in terms of revenues generated; and 26 WHEREAS, more than 50,000 Duval County residents are employed 27 in the tourism industry; and 28 WHEREAS, Jacksonville welcomes over 22 million overnight and 29 day trippers annually in Jacksonville. These visitors contributed 30 approximately \$4 billion to the local economy annually; and 31 WHEREAS, in the United States, tourism produced an economic

1 footprint of \$2.6 trillion - a return to 2019 levels, and directly
2 employed over 8 million people; and

WHEREAS, as people throughout the world become increasingly aware of the beautiful natural surroundings, outstanding cultural and recreational opportunities, and warm Southern hospitality of our residents available in Jacksonville, travel will become an increasingly vital resource in improving America's image around the world and an extension of our public diplomacy; and

9 WHEREAS, given these laudable contributions to the economic, 10 social and cultural well-being of the citizens of Jacksonville, it 11 is fitting that the City recognize the importance of the American 12 travel industry; now therefore
