10 WHEREAS, National Historic Preservation Month was established 11 in 1973 by the National Trust for Historic Preservation to promote 12 historic places, encourage heritage tourism, and to show the social 13 and economic benefits of historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, each May, historical societies, municipalities, and other organizations join to promote the preservation of historic places and raise awareness of the value of history; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville is proud to have numerous properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places, as well as ten historic neighborhoods and districts: Avondale, Downtown Jacksonville, Durkee Gardens, Eastside, Edward Waters University, Old Ortega, Riverside, San Marco, Springfield, and St. Johns Quarter; and
