PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Council Research will complete this form for Council introduced legislation and the Administration is responsible for all other legislation.

This legislation is necessary for the City to partner with the Jaguars for the funding of programs critical to the future growth of the city. It commits the City to dedicating minimum funding levels in future budget years to support Workforce Development and Affordable Housing/Homeless Mitigation efforts countywide (\$50m total over 4 years beginning FY 25/26) as well as Economic Development and Affordable Housing/Homeless Mitigation efforts in the "Outeast neighborhood as designated on the attached map" \$30m total over 3 years beginning FY 25/26). Having dedicated and committed funding allocated for future budgets will allow for more effective project planning and greater opportunities to compete for matching grants at the present time. The legislation also creates a commitment from the Jaguars to contribute annual funding over the term of the lease. Legislation commits \$14m in CIP funding on or before the date that is the two year anniversary of the Stadium Lease Effective Date for each district Councilmember to appropriate toward parks, public spaces, resiliency, infrastructure and/or recreation purposes in such district.
