Bill Summary: This bill reappoints Council Member Ron Salem to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee, as a liaison, for a term concurrent with the term of the Council President for the 2024-2025 Council Year.

Background Information: The Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee is established through Section 84.201, *Ordinance Code* to ensure the Opioid Settlement Proceeds are utilized in a way that maximizes the impact of these dollars in addressing the devastating effects of the opioid epidemic, to act as an advisory body for the City of Jacksonville, and to review, evaluate, and score grant applications to fund projects and programs aimed at combatting the opioid crisis.

Pursuant to Section 84.202 (b), *Ordinance Code*, the City Council President shall annually appoint a City Council Member to serve as a liaison to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee. This is a non-voting position and shall not be considered a member of the OSUD Grants Committee for Sunshine purposes.
