**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the appointment of Denis Monyo, P.E. as a member of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to the Concurrency & Mobility Management System Office, filling a seat formerly held by Rajesh K. Chindalur, for a first full-term ending June 30, 2026.

**Background Information:** The TAC to the Concurrency and Mobility Management Systems Office is established pursuant to Chapter 655, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to assist in the development of an updated Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook and serve as technical advisors in appeals of concurrency and mobility decisions.

Section 655.122(b), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include three licensed professional traffic engineers appointed by the President of the City Council.

Mr. Monyo holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, and a master's degree in civil engineering from UNF. He is a professional engineer registered in the state of Florida. Mr. Monyo has worked for Peters and Yaffee Inc. since 2020. Mr. Monyo resides in Duval County in council district 2.
