5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$790,631.03 IN GRANT
6 FUNDS FROM THE VOTING ACCESS FOR INDIVIDUALS
7 WITH DISABILITIES (VOTE) PROGRAM, AWARDED BY THE
8 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
9 (HHS) THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT
10 OF STATE, DIVISION OF ELECTIONS, TO PROVIDE
11 REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE
12 "CITY") FOR THE COSTS OF OFFSETTING ANY
13 REMAINING VARIANCES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025
14 BUDGET AND FUNDING SECURITY AND BUILDING
15 ENHANCEMENTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-141;
16 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO SUBSEQUENT
17 FISCAL YEARS; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE
18 SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
19 DATE.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
23 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
25 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above represents
2 grant funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human
3 Services (HHS) through the State of Florida, Department of
4 State, Division of Elections that dropped into the
5 Supervisor of Elections fund balance and which is
6 appropriated to the Supervisor of Elections Grants -
7 Miscellaneous Services and Charges account (549040) to be
8 used for reimbursement of the City's costs of offsetting
9 any remaining budget variances for the Fiscal Year 2025
10 and funding security and building enhancements. No local
11 match is required.

12 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
13 Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for the costs of offsetting
14 any remaining variances for the Fiscal Year 2025 budget and funding
15 security and building enhancements.

16 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Supervisor of Elections shall
17 oversee the project and the grant described herein.

18 **Section 4. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
19 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into subsequent
20 fiscal years.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
