5 A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING COUNCIL MEMBER RON
6 SALEM TO THE OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
7 GRANTS COMMITTEE, AS A LIAISON, PURSUANT TO
8 SECTION 84.202(b), *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A TERM
9 CONCURRENT WITH THE TERM OF THE COUNCIL
10 PRESIDENT FOR THE 2024-2025 COUNCIL YEAR;
11 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2019-56-E enacted February 26, 2019,
14 created a new Chapter 84 (Opioid Abuse Mitigation), *Ordinance Code*,
15 and established the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2023-350-E enacted June 27, 2023, repealed
17 Chapter 84 (Opioid Abuse Mitigation), *Ordinance Code*, in its entirety,
18 and created a new Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants),
19 *Ordinance Code*, which established the Opioid and Substance Use
20 Disorder (OSUD) Grants Committee; and

21 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 84.202(b), *Ordinance Code*, the
22 City Council President shall annually appoint a City Council Member
23 to serve as a liaison to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants
24 Committee. This is a non-voting position and shall not be considered
25 a member of the OSUD Grants Committee for Sunshine purposes; now
26 therefore

27 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Reappointment.** The Council hereby confirms the
29 reappointment of Council Member Ron Salem, to the Opioid and Substance
30 Use Disorder Grants Committee, as a liaison, pursuant to Section
31 84.202(b), *Ordinance Code*, for a term concurrent with the term of the

1 Council President for the 2024-2025 Council Year.

2 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
