Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 154.107 (Sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in municipal parks or on City-owned or -leased property; penalty), *Ordinance Code*.

Background Information: The purpose of this Legislation is to add the airport as a public location where alcohol may be sold and consumed. With this amendment, alcoholic beverages, purchased or served under the authority of any alcohol license issued to the Jacksonville Aviation Authority, may be sold, served and consumed at any time at the Jacksonville International Airport located at 2400 Yankee Clipper Drive and as otherwise consistent with State of Florida law and City Municipal Code requirements.

Policy Impact Area: Sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages - Airport

Fiscal Impact: No direct cost to the City
