**Type of Action:** Approving modification/renewal of solid waste certificate of public convenience and necessity (CON), subject to conditions

**Bill Summary:** The bill approves the renewal and modification of the solid waste Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON) for the Hrustic Brothers Inc. Clean Debris Recycling Facility, located at 6498 Fayal Drive South and the expansion of such facility onto the adjacent parcel located at located 11901 Fayal Drive, owned by Hrustic Brothers, Inc. The facility will serve the public convenience and provide a needed service to the citizens of Duval County, based upon the criteria set forth in Section 380.105, *Ordinance Code*. The application has been reviewed by the Public Works Department, the Solid Waste Division, the Environmental Quality Division, the Planning and Development Department and the Florida Department of Health in Duval County and the applicant requirements for operation of such a facility have been met.

**Background Information:** Section 380, *Ordinance Code* establishes that those who wish to establish and maintain solid waste management facilities apply for and receive a Certificate of Need. The CON for Hrustic Brothers Inc was originally granted by via Ordinance 2015-374-E. The modified CON allows for the expansion of the facility to an adjoining parcel.

The company is subject to 32 specific conditions for operation of the site. These include: a prominent entrance sign, a limit to accept 1200 tons of materials per day, properly trained personnel, waste control, a monthly Waste Analysis Report, limits on stockpiling and storage pile heights, operating hours Monday through Friday from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., noise/litter/odor control, stormwater management, security, and a minimum setback distance of 100-feet between all groundwater wells and all fuel storage tanks.
