9 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
10 (HHS) THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT
11 OF STATE, DIVISION OF ELECTIONS, TO PROVIDE
12 REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE
13 "CITY") FOR THE COSTS OF OFFSETTING ANY
14 REMAINING VARIANCES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025
15 BUDGET AND FUNDING SECURITY AND BUILDING
16 ENHANCEMENTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-141;
17 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO SUBSEQUENT
18 FISCAL YEARS; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE
19 SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
25 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

(c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above represents grant funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) through the State of Florida, Department of State, Division of Elections that dropped into the Supervisor of Elections Grant Fund fund balance and which is appropriated to the Supervisor of Elections Grants - Miscellaneous Services and Charges account (549040) to be used for reimbursement of the City's costs of offsetting any remaining budget variances for the Fiscal Year 2025 and funding security and building enhancements. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for the costs of offsetting any remaining variances for the Fiscal Year 2025 budget and funding security and building enhancements.

Section 3. Oversight. The Supervisor of Elections shall oversee the project and the grant described herein.

Section 4. Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into subsequent fiscal years.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
