7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$455,000.00 FROM THE  
8 UNDERDRAIN REPLACEMENTS PROJECT TO THE  
9 BROOKSHIRE COURT UNDERDRAIN REHABILITATION  
10 PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") TO PAY FOR THE REMOVAL  
11 AND REPLACEMENT OF APPROXIMATELY 835 FEET OF  
12 EXISTING UNDERDRAIN ON BROOKSHIRE COURT, AS  
13 INITIATED BY B.T. 24-145; AMENDING THE 2025-2029  
14 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY  
15 ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT THIS  
16 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING  
17 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND  
18 CONSTRUCTION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
19 PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
23 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
25 listed in subsection (b):

27 by this reference)

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
3 \$455,000.00 from the Underdrain Replacements Project to  
4 the Brookshire Court Underdrain Rehabilitation Project.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
6 Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Underdrain Replacements  
7 Project to the Brookshire Court Underdrain Rehabilitation Project  
8 (the "Project") for the construction and installation of the Project.  
9 The Project will entail removal and replacement of approximately 835  
10 feet of existing underdrain on Brookshire Court and tie into the  
11 existing inlet drainage system. The Project will reduce driveway  
12 flooding along Brookshire Court and improve drainage at surrounding  
13 ponds.

14 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance  
15 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan  
16 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is  
17 hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project,  
18 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached  
19 hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP  
20 Sheets, September 30, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this  
21 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment  
22 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be  
23 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
24 deferral will unnecessarily delay the commencement and completion of  
25 the Project.

26 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
27 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
28 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP  
29 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute  
30 an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the  
31 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E

1 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

2           **Section 4.**           The Engineering and Construction Division of the  
3 Department of Public Works shall have oversight with respect to the  
4 project described herein.

5           **Section 5.           Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
7 without the Mayor's signature.
