5 **ORDINANCE 2024-769-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE  
7 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
8 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SECOND  
9 AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2021-2022 CITY GRANT  
10 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND  
11 REGIONAL FOOD BANK OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC.  
12 D/B/A FEEDING NORTHEAST FLORIDA (THE  
13 "AGREEMENT"), TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE  
14 AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, TO  
15 EXTEND CERTAIN OTHER RELATED DATES AND DEADLINES  
16 WITHIN THE AGREEMENT, TO REVISE THE AGREEMENT TO  
17 PROVIDE THAT THE CITY FUNDS WILL BE USED FOR A  
18 ROOF REPLACEMENT AT REGIONAL FOOD BANK OF  
19 NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. D/B/A FEEDING NORTHEAST  
20 FLORIDA'S NEW LOCATION AT 5245 OLD KINGS ROAD,  
21 AND TO AMEND THE OVERALL PROJECT COST TO \$1.2  
22 MILLION WITH ALL FUNDING BEING PROVIDED BY THE  
23 CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE  
24 GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION;  
25 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;  
26 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

28 **WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2021-504-E (the FY 21-22 Budget Ordinance)  
29 appropriated \$1,200,000 to Regional Food Bank of Northeast Florida,  
30 Inc. d/b/a Feeding Northeast Florida ("FNEFL") for the Farmers Market  
31 and Resource Center and authorized the Mayor, or her designee, and

1 the Corporation Secretary to execute, on behalf of the City, a grant  
2 agreement between the City and FNEFL; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the term of the FY 2021-2022 City Grant Agreement  
4 between the City of Jacksonville and FNEFL (the "Agreement") dated  
5 September 21, 2022, as amended by that First Amendment dated September  
6 18, 2023, is currently set to expire on September 30, 2024; and

7 **WHEREAS**, FNEFL has requested an extension to the term of the  
8 Agreement and further is requesting to use a portion of the City  
9 funds to replace the roof at FNEFL's new facility; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the City Council therefore desires to extend the term  
11 of the Agreement to September 30, 2025, and to amend the Agreement  
12 to authorize use of the City funds for replacement of the roof at  
13 FNEFL's new facility at 5245 Old Kings Road; now therefore

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute an**  
16 **Amendment to Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or  
17 her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to  
18 execute and deliver a second amendment to the FY 2021-2022 City Grant  
19 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Regional Food Bank of  
20 Northeast Florida, Inc. d/b/a Feeding Northeast Florida ("FNEFL")  
21 (City Contract #72025-22) (the "Agreement"), to extend the term of  
22 the Agreement to September 30, 2025, to extend related dates based  
23 on the extension to the term authorized herein, to revise the  
24 Agreement to authorize use of the City funds for a roof replacement  
25 at FNEFL's new location at 5245 Old Kings Road, and to amend the  
26 overall project cost to \$1.2 million with all funding coming from the  
27 City. All other provisions including the clawback provisions and  
28 reimbursement will remain in place except as needed to account for  
29 the extension of time and use of the City funds. The extension  
30 authorized herein will be retroactive to October 1, 2024, to ensure  
31 there is no lapse in the contract term.

1           **Section 2.           Oversight.** The Office of Economic Development  
2 shall continue to have oversight of the Agreement described herein.

3           **Section 3.           Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**  
4 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this  
5 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that FNEFL  
6 has requested the City funds be made available as soon as possible  
7 as their new facility requires an immediate roof replacement.

8           **Section 4.           Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
10 without the Mayor's signature.
