Type of Action: Appropriation, *Ordinance Code* exemption, agreement authorization and designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$100,000 from a Special Council Contingency to the Pre-Trial Operations Activity – Contractual Services account within the Jacksonville Sheriff’s Office. The Exemption in Section 126.108(g), *Ordinance Code* is invoked to permit the direct procurement of professional services. The grant agreement with the City and CGL Management Services, LLC is authorized. The Jacksonville Sheriff’s Office will provide oversight.

Background Information: Last year, the Special Committee of the City Council to Review JSO Primary Facilities conducted an in-depth review of the current pre-trial detention center, jail processes, and the condition of the Police Memorial Building. The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for a study and analysis of the Duval County jail population. The study will be conducted over a 6–8-month period by CGL Management Services, LLC, a firm with 50 years of experience in justice facility planning, design, program management and maintenance solutions. The study will include: an assessment of available data (aggregate and individual case level data files), an analysis of the jail population and classification system, and the development of a baseline 10-year projection of trends and drivers of the jail population.

Policy Impact Area: Study and analysis of the Duval County jail population

Fiscal Impact: Appropriation of \$100,000

Analyst: Hampsey
