6 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING DR. DANA KRIZNAR FOR HER
7 DECADES OF SERVICE IN DUVAL COUNTY PUBLIC
8 SCHOOLS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Dana Kriznar holds a bachelor's degree from Iowa
11 State University, a master's degree from the University of North
12 Florida, and her Ph.D. in Educational Administration, Research and
13 Policy from the University of Florida; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Kriznar began her career in education as a math
15 teacher in 1986, teaching at John Gorrie Junior High School and
16 Mandarin Middle School; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Kriznar entered school administration in 1993,
18 and in 2001 she received her first assignment as Principal at Thomas
19 Jefferson Elementary School where she led the school from a grade of
20 "C" to an "A" in two years; she was then named Principal of Kirby
21 Smith Middle School (now Springfield Middle School), where she also
22 led the improvement of that school's grade from "C" to "A" in three
23 years; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Dana Kriznar has served Duval County Public
25 Schools with distinction as a teacher, Vice Principal, Assistant
26 Principal, Principal, Executive Director, Assistant Superintendent,
27 Chief of Staff, Deputy Superintendent, and Superintendent; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Kriznar is retiring after a stellar career
29 dedicated to supporting student achievement and cultivating academic
30 excellence; now therefore

31 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby commends Dr. Dana
2 Kriznar upon her retirement for her years of service to Duval County
3 Public Schools. The City Council appreciates her commitment to public
4 education, her leadership in roles throughout the district, and her
5 willingness to always step up to do what is needed, when it is needed.

6 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
8 without the Mayor's signature.
