

## NCSPHS AMENDMENT

The Neighborhoods, Community Services, Public Health and Safety Committee offers the following amendment to File No. 2024-807:

- (1) On **page 1, line 7**, after "STATUTES;" **insert** "DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE, WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF ITS ENACTMENT, TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE SPECIAL DISTRICT ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM, THE DUVAL COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE, AND THE HOGPEN DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT;";
- (2) On **page 1, lines 20-24**, **strike** "Per section 189.076, Florida Statutes, the dissolution transfers title to all property owned by the Hogpen Dependent Special District to the City, which also assumes all indebtedness of the preexisting Hogpen Dependent Special District." and **insert** "As part of the dissolution, the Hogpen Dependent Special District (the "District") shall resolve any debts of the District consistent with Section 189.062, *Florida Statutes*, and shall refund any remaining unspent and unobligated moneys collected as assessments by the District consistent with Section 189.021, *Florida Statutes*.";
- (3) On **page 1, line 24½**, **insert** a new Section to read as follows:  

**"Section 2. Directive to Chief of Legislative Services Division.** The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby directed to provide a copy of this legislation, within thirty days of its enactment, to the

Florida Department of Commerce Special District  
Accountability Program, the Duval County Tax Collector's  
Office, and the Hogpen Dependent Special District.";

- (4) Renumber the remaining Section accordingly;
- (5) On **page 1, line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add  
that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
