4 **ORDINANCE 2024-949**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$70,296 FROM A
6 GENERAL FUND OPERATING SPECIAL COUNCIL
7 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND
8 OPERATING SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE
9 ORG ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO
10 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA ("UNF") FOR THE UNF
11 MILITARY AND VETERANS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS
12 DESCRIBED HEREIN; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
13 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
14 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF
15 THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
16 JACKSONVILLE AND UNF FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING
17 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT
18 COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT;
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,
23 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
25 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above is an appropriation of \$70,296 from a
3 General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency account
4 to the General Fund Operating Subsidies and Contributions
5 to Private Org account, to provide a grant to University
6 of North Florida ("UNF") for the UNF Military and Veterans
7 Program (the "Program") as described herein.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to
10 the University of North Florida for the UNF Military and Veterans
11 Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and incorporated
12 herein by this reference. The Program is operated out of the UNF
13 Military and Veterans Resource Center (the "MVRC") which serves over
14 2,000 military-connected students and provides access to technology
15 and equipment to assist students in their educational pursuits as
16 well as a location for work study groups, completion of class
17 projects, student collaborations, and development of presentations.
18 Two specific programs offered at the UNF MVRC that will be supported
19 by the City grant dollars include the SBDC Military Spouse Career
20 Readiness Seminar and the Veteran/Military Student Entrepreneurship
21 Bootcamp and Pitch Competition. The Spouse Career Readiness Seminar
22 provides targeted training, mentorship and resources to help military
23 spouses explore entrepreneurship opportunities as a viable career
24 path while the Bootcamp and Pitch Competition were designed to provide
25 opportunities for military and veteran students attending UNF to
26 explore innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship and to develop
27 the skillset necessary to achieve their entrepreneurship goals.

28 The City funds will be used to purchase two interactive
29 electronic whiteboards for installation in the main area and a private
30 study room at the MVRC and to purchase equipment and make improvements
31 to the MVRC kitchen where military-connected students have access to

1 free refreshments throughout the day. A portion of the City funds
2 will also be used to purchase a golf cart to transport disabled and
3 mobility-challenged veterans and military-connected students around
4 the MVRC campus. Finally, a portion of the funds will be used for
5 office expenses, space rentals, and marketing materials as well as a
6 portion of the salaries and benefits for a Coordinator and a
7 Facilitator to support the SBRC Military Spouse Career Readiness
8 Seminar and a Cohort Facilitator and Mentors for the Entrepreneurship
9 Bootcamp and Pitch Competition.

10 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is
11 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
12 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
13 the City a grant agreement with University of North Florida in an
14 amount not-to-exceed \$70,296, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget
15 more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on
16 October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and all other contracts
17 and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the
18 agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate
19 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and
20 approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the
21 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and
22 indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601,
23 *Ordinance Code*.

24 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Grants and Contract
25 Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the
26 project described herein.

27 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
