5 **RESOLUTION 2024-958**

6 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE STATE ATTORNEY OF  
7 THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT'S APPOINTMENT OF  
8 OCTAVIUS A. HOLLIDAY, JR., A DUVAL COUNTY  
9 RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE  
10 JOURNEY FORWARD BOARD, PURSUANT TO SECTION  
11 85.105, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR AN INITIAL THREE-  
12 YEAR TERM EXPIRING SEPTEMBER 30, 2027; PROVIDING  
13 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2024-635-E established the Jacksonville  
16 Journey Forward as a public body within the executive branch of the  
17 City to assess and make recommendations regarding community-based  
18 programs, services, activities, and contracts related to factors  
19 contributing to crime prevention, intervention, and rehabilitation  
20 as well as neighborhood safety and stability, and the prevention of  
21 juvenile and adult recidivism; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Journey Forward also serves as a  
23 convenor to organize and engage City agencies, offices, departments,  
24 independent agencies, and community leaders and stakeholders to  
25 establish a community-based, Citywide plan and alignment of resources  
26 to reduce factors contributing to crime and to improve public safety;  
27 and

28 **WHEREAS**, Section 85.105(a), *Ordinance Code*, outlines the  
29 composition of the Jacksonville Journey Forward Board ("JF Board")  
30 which shall consist of eleven voting members, four of whom are  
31 appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, three of whom shall

1 be appointed by the Council President and confirmed by Council with  
2 the following persons making one appointment for confirmation by  
3 Council, to wit: the Sheriff of Duval County, the State Attorney of  
4 the Fourth Judicial Circuit, the Superintendent of Duval County Public  
5 Schools, and the Chief Judge for the Fourth Judicial Circuit; and

6 **WHEREAS**, to the extent feasible and preferred, but not required,  
7 members appointed to serve on the JF Board shall include individuals  
8 with experience in one or more of the following areas, recognizing  
9 these qualifications would best serve the mission and objectives of  
10 the Jacksonville Journey Forward: public health, education, workforce  
11 development, contracts and compliance, afterschool/camp operations,  
12 juvenile diversion programs, violence prevention or intervention, ex-  
13 offender re-entry programs, law enforcement and community engagement;  
14 now therefore

15 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appointment Confirmation.** The Council hereby  
17 confirms the State Attorney of the Fourth Judicial Circuit's  
18 appointment of Octavius A. Holliday, Jr., a Duval County resident,  
19 as a member of the Jacksonville Journey Forward Board, in accordance  
20 with Section 85.105, *Ordinance Code*, for an initial three-year term  
21 expiring on September 30, 2027.

22 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
