Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$2,500,000 from the Mobility Fee—Zone 9 Project to the Moncrief Road Beautification (34th- 45th Street) Project to fund design and construction costs. The project includes intersections improvements, vehicular and pedestrian signal upgrades, concrete sidewalks, curbs, gutters, pedestrian overpass aesthetics, and landscaping enhancements. It also amends the 2025-2029 Five Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) adopted by Ordinance 2024-505-E to reflect this appropriation. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works will oversee the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funding for the Moncrief Road Beautification Project, which aims to enhance safety for traffic, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The project includes significant improvements to intersections and pedestrian infrastructure, reconditioning of the overpass, and landscaping to improve the area's aesthetic appeal. Oversight will be provided by the Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works.

Policy Impact Area: Roadway improvements
