7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$26,850.63 IN FUNDS
8 RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF THAT CERTAIN 2023 FORD
9 TRANSIT 350 CARGO VAN (PROPERTY NUMBER 2030296,
10 VIN 1FTBW3X8XPKA22994) AND TWO MACBOOK COMPUTERS
11 (PROPERTY NUMBER 2030294, SERIAL NO. F45X96VHHK,
12 AND PROPERTY NUMBER 2030295, SERIAL NO.
13 F9JR4YC6YM) (THE "PROPERTY") TO THE OPIOID
14 SETTLEMENT FUND FOR FUTURE AWARDS, AS INITIATED
15 BY B.T. 25-069; DECLARING THE PROPERTY TO BE
16 SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY, AND
17 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE
18 CITY TO TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO ACE
19 MEDICAL, LLC ("COMPANY"), LOCATED AT 6428 BEACH
20 BOULEVARD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32216, AT A
21 COST OF \$26,850.63; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF
22 SECTION 122.812(C) (SURPLUS, OBSOLETE AND WASTE
23 SUPPLIES AND OTHER TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY),
24 PART 8 (TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY), CHAPTER 122
25 (PUBLIC PROPERTY), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW FOR
26 THE SALE OF THE PROPERTY TO THE COMPANY;
27 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,
31 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

1 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
2 listed in subsection (b):

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

10 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$26,850.63
11 received from the sale of that certain 2023 Ford Transit
12 350 Cargo Van (Property Number 2030296, VIN
13 1FTBW3X8XPKA22994) and two Macbook computers (Property
14 Number 2030294, Serial No. F45X96VHHK, and Property Number
15 2030295, Serial No. F9JR4YC6YM), (the "Property") to the
16 Opioid Settlement Fund to be used for future awards.

17 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
18 Section 1 is to allocate funds received from the sale of the Property
19 to Ace Medical, LLC (the "Company"), to the Opioid Settlement Fund
20 to be used for future awards. The Property was originally purchased
21 by the Company, in part, with grant funds received from the City of
22 Jacksonville Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants (OSPG) Program during
23 the Fiscal Year 2023-2024.

24 **Section 3. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby
25 declares that certain 2023 Ford Transit 350 Cargo Van (Property Number
26 2030296, VIN 1FTBW3X8XPKA22994) valued at approximately \$33,164.00,
27 and two Macbook computers (Property Number 2030294, Serial No.
28 F45X96VHHK, and Property Number 2030295, Serial No. F9JR4YC6YM)
29 valued at a total of approximately \$2,640.91, to be surplus to the
30 needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City
31 officials to transfer title of the Property to the Company, located

1 at 6428 Beach Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32216, at a cost of
2 \$26,850.63. Copies of the property transfer forms are attached hereto
3 as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Transfer
4 Forms, May 19, 2025 - NCSPHS".

5 **Section 4. Waiving Section 122.812(c) (Surplus, obsolete**
6 **and waste supplies and other tangible personal property), Ordinance**
7 **Code.** The provisions of 122.812(c) (Surplus, obsolete and waste
8 supplies and other tangible personal property), Part 8 (Tangible
9 Personal Property), Chapter 122 (Public Property), *Ordinance Code*,
10 are hereby waived to allow the Property to be conveyed to the Company
11 for less than fair market value without including within this
12 legislation the following provisions: 1) a statement of the use to
13 which the Property will be put and the public purpose to be achieved
14 by the directed disposition of the Property; 2) designation of an
15 appropriate City department or agency to monitor the actual use of
16 the Property and achievement of the stated public purpose after the
17 transfer of the Property; and 3) a reverter clause requiring the
18 Property to be returned to the City should it be put to a use other
19 than the stated public purpose for which it was conveyed. The Property
20 was originally purchased by the Company, in part, with grant funds
21 received from the City of Jacksonville Opioid Settlement Proceeds
22 Grants (OSPG) Program during the Fiscal Year 2023-2024, with the
23 remaining amount being paid by the Company. The sales price of
24 \$26,850.63 represents the amount of the original grant funds used
25 minus the depreciation of the Property.

26 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
