25 Section 5. Amending Ordinance 2018-504-E by amending 26 Attachment A ("Food and Beverage Expenditures"). Ordinance 2018-27 504-E is amended by amending Attachment A thereto ("Food and 28 Beverage Expenditures") by substituting a new Fourth Revised 29 Attachment A, attached hereto as Exhibit 3, incorporated herein by 30 this reference, and made a part of Ordinance 2018-504-E, in order to allow funds to be spent on food and beverages at shelter events. 31
