BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Adoption of recommended findings and conclusions. The Council has reviewed the record of proceedings for the Appeal of the Final Order denying Application for Certificate of Appropriateness COA-18-21264, which requested to paint unpainted masonry.
