Type of Action: Reappointment Confirmation

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Raul E. Arias, Jr., as a member of the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission (JHCDC), filling the seat formerly held by Lenny Curry, as a representative of employers in Duval County, for a first term ending November 30, 2022.

Background Information: The JHCDC is established pursuant to Chapter 35, *Ordinance Code*, in accordance with Section 420.9076, *Florida Statutes*, and charged to act as an advisory committee, conduct any required public hearings, undertake the review, take any and all required actions for compliance, and make recommendations to the Council for adoption (and authorize the transmittal) as required by section 420.9076, *Florida Statutes*, regarding local affordable housing incentives. Section 30.703(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that six of the eleven members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, in various categories, including a representative of employers in Duval County.

Mr. Arias received an associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville and is the Owner / Operator of *Mambos Cuban Café*. He resides in the East Arlington area within Council District #2.

Attendance: Mr. Arias has an attendance record of 13 meetings attended of 15 (86%).
