ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN RYALS CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ("RYALS CREEK CDD"); DESCRIBING THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF RYALS CREEK CDD; NAMING RYALS CREEK CDD; NAMING THE INITIAL RYALS CREEK CDD BOARD OF AMENDING (UNIFORM SUPERVISORS; CHAPTER 92 DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS), ORDINANCE CODE, SECTION 92.22 (EXISTING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS) TO INCLUDE RYALS CREEK CDD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 WHEREAS, Sawmill Timber, LLC, a Florida limited liability corporation, petitioned the City Council to establish a community 18 development district named Ryals Creek Community Development 19 District (the "Ryals Creek CDD") on approximately 414.19 acres 20 lying wholly within the boundaries of the City pursuant to Section 21 22 190.005(2), F.S., and Chapter 92, Ordinance Code, a copy of the Amended Petition to Establish Ryals Creek CDD, dated July 16, 2019, 23 ("Petition") is on file with the Legislative Services Division; and 24

WHEREAS, as required by Section 92.07, Ordinance Code, the Office of General Counsel ("Counsel") has reviewed the Petition, and finding that it was sufficient and complete to permit the fair and informed consideration of the matter by the Council, has prepared and submitted its Final Report of Counsel, attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

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WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has provided

its report and recommendation regarding the Petition to the
 Transportation, Energy and Utilities Committee; and

3 WHEREAS, Petitioner acknowledges that nothing about the adoption of this Ordinance shall in any way waive any of the 4 City's, or any other governing or regulatory entities' rights to 5 grant or not grant entitlements for the development to be serviced 6 7 by Ryals Creek (the "Development"), or otherwise prejudice the 8 City's, or any other governing or regulatory entities', ability to 9 govern or regulate the planning or permitting of the Development; 10 and

WHEREAS, Counsel has determined the Petition adequately meets the requirements of Section 190.005, F.S. and Section 92.04, *Ordinance Code* and is therefore complete and sufficient to permit fair and informed review thereof; and

WHEREAS, all notice requirements of Ch. 190, F.S., Section 92.11, Ordinance Code, and other applicable laws were complied with, complete notice was timely given, and a public hearing held on the date and time noticed and conducted thereafter in compliance with Ch. 190, F.S. and all applicable laws; and

20 WHEREAS, in making its fair and informed determination whether 21 to grant or deny the Petition, the Council has considered the 22 petition in light of the record developed at the public hearing and 23 in relation to the six factors set forth in Section 190.005(1)(e), 24 F.S., now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Name. A community development district is
hereby established within the City to be known hereafter as Ryals
Creek Community Development District.

29 **Section 2. Boundaries.** The boundaries of Ryals Creek 30 Community Development District established by this ordinance are as 31 set forth in the legal description contained in the Petition to

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Establish Ryals Creek Community Development District ("Petition") which is on file with the Legislative Services Division. The legal description and boundary sketch found within the Petition are attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

5 Section 3. Board of Supervisors. The following five 6 persons, as set forth in the Petition, are designated to be the 7 initial members of the governing Board of Supervisors ("Board") of 8 Ryals Creek Community Development District:

- 9 a. Arthur Chester Skinner, III
- 10 b. Christopher John Eyrick
- 11 c. Jan Malcolm Jones, III
- 12 d. Clayton Riley Skinner
- 13 e. Lee Vaughn Webb, Jr.

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14 Section 4. Amending 92 Chapter (Uniform Community 15 Development Districts), Section 92.22 (Existing Community 16 Development Districts), Ordinance Code. Section 92.22, Ordinance 17 Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 Sec. 92.22. - Existing Community Development Districts.

The following CDDs have been established in the City:

20 (1) Bainebridge Community Development District. The
21 Bainebridge Community Development District was
22 established in Ordinance 2005-1417-E. The City granted
23 consent to the Bainebridge Community Development District
24 to exercise special powers related to parks and
25 facilities for indoor and outdoor recreational, cultural
26 and educational uses in Ordinance 2006-592-E.

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(20) Ryals Creek *Community Development District*. Ryals Creek <u>Community Development District was established in</u> Ordinance 2019-490-E. Section 5. Conflict and Severability. Any portion of this ordinance determined finally by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in conflict with prevailing law shall not be effective to the extent of such conflict, and shall be deemed severable and the remainder shall continue in full force and effect to the extent legally possible.

7 Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming law without 9 the Mayor's signature.
