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ORDINANCE 2019-501

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING ANNUAL TAXES FOR THE 2019 CALENDAR YEAR ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, NOT INCLUDING THE SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH AND FIFTH URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS (THE CITIES OF ATLANTIC BEACH, NEPTUNE BEACH, JACKSONVILLE BEACH AND THE TOWN OF BALDWIN); STATING THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE FROM THE 2019 ROLLED-BACK RATE; AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE REVENUES GENERATED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services District, excepting Urban Service Districts 2 through 5 20 (The 21 Beaches and the Town of Baldwin). In accordance with Chapter 200, 22 Florida Statutes, for the year 2019, there are hereby levied upon 23 all taxable property located within the General Services District 24 of the city, excepting the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Urban 25 Services Districts, for county, district and municipal purposes, ad 26 valorem taxes expressed in terms of mills on each dollar of 27 assessed taxable valuation in the amount of 11.4419 mills, or 28 \$11.4419 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value.

Section 2. Percentage increase from the rolled-back rate.
The 2019 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated
City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services

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District of the city, excepting the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth
 Urban Services Districts, represents a 5.84% increase from the 2019
 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2019-500-A.

4 Section 3. Assessment and collection. The Property 5 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and 6 the Tax Collector of the County is authorized and directed to 7 collect, pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this 8 ordinance.

9 Section 4. Use of revenues. The revenues raised by the 10 ad valorem taxes levied in this ordinance shall be utilized in the 11 manner and for the purposes specified in the 2019-2020 budget and 12 appropriations ordinance.

13 Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Council President.
