A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE TRINITY CHRISTIAN ACADEMY'S GIRLS' SOFTBALL TEAM ON WINNING THE FLORIDA CLASS 4A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Trinity Christian Conquerors girls softball team finished their regular season with a 15-6 record, winning the District 2 championship and the right to host the opening rounds of the playoffs; and

WHEREAS, a 10-0 shutout of Florida High of Tallahassee and a 5-1 victory over district rival Providence earned the Conquerors a trip to the state semifinals, where they defeated Oxbridge Academy on the road in West Palm Beach by a score of 10-3 to send them to the Class 4A championship game against powerhouse Westminster Christian of Miami, the 2-time defending state champions and winners of the state title in four of the last five years; and

WHEREAS, the Conquerors, appearing in a rematch of the 2018 championship game won by the Westminster Warriors by a 6-1 score, produced a win for the ages in their seventh trip to the final four and fifth championship game with a resounding 16-0 victory in Vero Beach in a 4-inning game halted by the "mercy rule", a score that tied the record for the largest margin of victory in a Florida softball title game; and

WHEREAS, led by Florida Dairy Farmers Class 4A Coach of the Year JR Borden and Amaya Ross, who finished third in the balloting for Class 4A Player of the Year, the Trinity Christian girls finally achieved the school's first ever softball state

championship and brought tremendous excitement and pride to the Jacksonville community; now therefore

The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and commends the Trinity Christian Academy Conquerors girls' softball team on their outstanding season and the school's first softball state championship.
