A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE CAREER AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF MIKE SANDS ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT AS CHIEF OF DEVELOPMENT SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Mike Sands earned his Associate of Science degree in civil engineering technology from Lake City Community College and graduated from the General Motors University of Automotive Management at Emory University; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sands held several private sector positions in the construction and engineering fields with various companies as a project estimator, survey party chief and engineering draftsman, and was working for Mandarin Utilities, a private water and sewer company, when it was acquired by the City of Jacksonville in 1986; and

WHEREAS, following the acquisition of the utility, Mike Sands began a long career with the City of Jacksonville and the JEA in the area of water and sewer operations, first as a contract employee in the Water Services Division of the Public Works Department, then as Water Services Construction Coordinator for the department. In 1997 when the City's water and sewer operations were transferred to the JEA, he was appointed as Director of Construction Management for Water and Sewer for the authority and served for several years on the JEA Corporate Strategy Team; and

WHEREAS, in 2002 Mr. Sands returned to the Public Works Department to take charge of the Development Management Group and,

after an administrative reorganization, was appointed Chief of the Development Services Division of the Planning and Development Department in 2007. He has been instrumental in managing the City's role in the tremendous growth that has taken place in the city over the past decade and played a leading role in developing Jacksonville's current floodplain ordinance which has helped the City to achieve National Flood Insurance Program community rating of 6, which qualified property owners in the city for a 20% reduction in flood insurance premiums; and

WHEREAS, an avid hunter, fisherman and camper, Mike Sands has also been an active contributor to his community as a member and Past Chairman of the Baker County Construction Adjustments and Appeals Board, as a board member of the Underground Utility Contractors Association of North Florida, and as a member of the Cecil Field Architectural Review Board; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and commends the career and accomplishments of Mike Sands as he retires from the position of Chief of the Development Services Division and extends its best wishes for health and happiness in the years ahead.
