AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; TO CLARIFY THAT THE CORRECT SPELLING OF "SPELLMAN ROAD" IN COUNCIL DISTRICT EXTENDING FROM BENEDICT ROAD ON THE NORTH TO WEST 45^{TH} STREET TO THE SOUTH SHOULD INCLUDE A "L"; WAIVING THESINGLE REQUIREMENTS SECTION 745.105 (D), ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE REVIEW BY THE 911 EMERGENCY ADDRESSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE; PROVIDING COMPLIANCE TIME PERIOD TO REQUIRE THAT ALL CITIZENS, PROPERTY OWNERS, BUSINESS OWNERS AND GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES UTILIZE THE CORRECT SPELLING OF "SPELMAN ROAD" WITH A SINGLE "L" ON ANY AND ALL OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS, RESIDENCE ADDRESSES, STREET SIGNS, HIGHWAY MARKERS AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2020; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

known Historically Black Colleges and Universities in America which are commonly referred to as "HBCUs"; and

WHEREAS, such streets are named in honor of Wilberforce University located in Wilberforce, Ohio, Benedict College located in Columbia, South Carolina, Xavier University located in New Orleans, Louisiana, Tuskegee University in Alabama, Meharry College in Tennessee and Spelman College located in Atlanta, Georgia as well as many others HBCUs; and

WHEREAS, historic documents reveal that "Wilberforce Road" was previously "Harvard Road," "Benedict Road" was previously "Cambridge Road," "Spelman Road" was "Dixie Road" and "Xavier Road" was previously named "Oxford Road"; and

WHEREAS, such documents included a Resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Duval County, Florida wherein the Duval Commissioners changed the name of "Dixie Road" to the new street name of "Spellman Road" using a double "L"; (A copy of the Resolution is attached as Exhibit 1); and

WHEREAS, a review of public resources reveals that Spelman College is spelled with a single "L." Such vital information was verified by a Spelman alumna who is a resident of Jacksonville, and a local attorney; and

WHEREAS, notably, Dr. Johnnetta Betsch Cole, a Jacksonville native and the granddaughter of Abraham Lincoln Lewis, was appointed the first black female President of Spelman College in 1987; and

WHEREAS, the misspelling of "Spelman Road" in the 1952 Duval County Resolution has, inadvertently, caused numerous inconsistencies and confusion about the correct spelling of "Spelman Road"; and

WHEREAS, the Council seeks to clarify that the correct spelling of "Spelman Road" should include a single "L"; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2019, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission ("JHPC") voted to adopt the Staff Report with a recommendation for approval to correct the spelling of "Spelman Road" with a single "L". A copy of the JHPC agenda, Staff Report, and the excerpt minutes of the May 22, 2019, public meeting of the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission are attached hereto as Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it appropriate to clarify the correct spelling of "Spelman Road" extending from Benedict Road on the north to West 45th Street on the south with a single "L"; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Spelman Road Correct Spelling Clarified. The correct spelling of the name of Spelman Road, extending from Benedict Road on the north to West 45th Street on the south, is hereby clarified by use of a single "L" by which name such street shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of Spelman Road is attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Map, August 5, 2019 - TEU".

Section 2. Waiver of Section 745.105(d), Ordinance Code,
Review by the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee.

Section 745.105(d), Ordinance Code, requiring review of all street name changes by the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee is hereby waived as the Ordinance is not changing the street name, but instead clarifies the correct spelling of "Spelman Road".

December 31, 2020. All citizens, property owners, business owners and governmental entities shall utilize the correct spelling of "Spelman Road" with a single "L" on any and all official documents, residence addresses, street signs, highway markers and electronic communication on or before December 31, 2020.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become Section 5. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
