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18 WHEREAS, the Council acts as a collegial body, and therefore 19 an inquiry of the City Council of the City of Jacksonville is 20 required to obtain an opinion from the Attorney General; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Request for an Opinion from the Florida
Attorney General. The City of Jacksonville hereby requests an
opinion from the Florida Attorney General specific to the following
inquiry:

- I. Whether the School Board may call a special
 election.
- 30 II. Whether the School Board may call a referendum31 election.

- III. Whether the City Council has the discretion to
 select the date of the referendum election.
- 3 IV. Whether the City Council has the discretion to 4 reject a School Board request to call a special 5 election to place a School Capital Surtax on the 6 ballot.
- 7 V. Whether the City Council has the discretion to
 8 refuse to place a School Capital Surtax on any
 9 ballot.
- 10 VI. Whether a court has the power to order the Council 11 to call a special election to hold a referendum on a 12 School Capital Surtax.
- 13 VII. Whether a court has the power to order the Council
 14 to place a School Capital Surtax on any ballot.

15 Section 2. General Counsel Opinion. The General Counsel 16 has reviewed and answered the above questions. A memorandum from 17 the General Counsel, substantially in the form attached hereto as 18 Exhibit 1, shall be attached to the request submitted to the 19 Attorney General.

20 Section 3. Direction to forward the resolution to the 21 Florida Attorney General. The City Council Legislative Services 22 Division is hereby directed to forward this request in the form of 23 the enacted resolution to Ashley Moody, Florida Attorney General.

Section 4. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that legislation, Ordinance 2019-380, requesting action on the Duval County School Board Resolution requesting a referendum is pending before Council.
