4 **ORDINANCE 2019-526-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF  
6 \$49,200 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY  
7 TO PAY FOR PROJECT COSTS FOR THE MIGRATION OF  
8 HISTORICAL DATA FROM EXISTING SYSTEMS TO THE  
9 GRANICUS PLATFORM; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER  
10 OF FUNDS INTO THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR;  
11 REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;  
12 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal  
16 year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
17 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
18 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

25 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

26 The funding above is being appropriated from the Council  
27 Operating Contingency to hardware/software maintenance  
28 and licenses within City Council Staff Services for costs  
29 related to the purchase of data migration services for  
30 historical data currently housed in existing legacy

1 systems International Roll Call, Haivision and OnBase  
2 into the Granicus platform. The data to be migrated  
3 includes meeting videos, agendas, minutes, agenda items,  
4 agenda action history and attachments. Migrated  
5 information will subsequently be available and viewable  
6 on the City Council's public facing web portal.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
8 Section 1 is to transfer funding to City Council for costs related  
9 to data migration of historical data currently housed in existing  
10 legacy systems International Roll Call, Haivision and OnBase into  
11 the Granicus platform. The data to be migrated includes meeting  
12 videos, agendas, minutes, agenda items, agenda action history and  
13 attachments. Migrated information will subsequently be available  
14 and viewable on the City Council's public facing web portal. The  
15 funding will also provide for continued maintenance, service, and  
16 support for the International Roll Call System until the migration  
17 is complete.

18 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1  
19 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
20 year 2019-2020.

21 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage**  
22 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency  
23 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the  
24 emergency is that the data migration of existing legacy systems  
25 must be purchased imminently to maintain historical data.

26 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
28 without the Mayor's signature.
