AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 2.95± ACRES LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8, AT 4343 SPRING GROVE AVENUE, BETWEEN WEST 33RD STREET AND SPRING GROVE AVENUE (R.E. NO. 029876-0000), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY GJORGJIEV, FROM PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES-2 (PBF-2) DISTRICT TO INDUSTRIAL LIGHT (IL) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Koce Gjorgjiev, the owner of approximately 2.95± acres located in Council District 8, at 4343 Spring Grove Road, between West 33rd Street and Spring Grove Avenue (R.E. WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations and all other evidence entered into the record and testimony taken at the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning: (1) is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Public Buildings and Facilities-2 (PBF-2) District to Industrial Light (IL) District, as defined and classified under the Zoning Code, City of Jacksonville, Florida.

Section 2. Owners and Description. The Subject Property is owned by Koce Gjorgjiev, and is described in Exhibit 1, attached hereto. The agent is Koce Gjorgjiev, 5315 Chestnut Lake Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32258; (307) 690-7808.

Section 3. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, laws, regulations, requirements, permits or state, or federal approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), any owners(s), developer(s) and/or authorized agent(s) designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this

rezoning does <u>not</u> approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

Section 4. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and Council Secretary.
