FOR USE AS TRANSPORT VEHICLE TO AID IN PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION TO ASSIST KIDS TO AND FROM PROGRAMS AS WELL AS SCHEDULED TRIPS, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 122.812(C), ORDINANCE CODE; DESIGNATING THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A REVERTER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS THE CORPORATE DESIGNEE AND SECRETARY EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SURPLUSSING OF CITY PERSONAL PROPERTY BETWEEN THECITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FAMILIES OF SLAIN CHILDREN OF JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Van declares that certain 2001 Chevrolet G3500 (VIN 1GAHG39R411167225, vehicle number 8056-10) valued at \$5,625, as more particularly described in **Exhibit 1** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Subject Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City officials to transfer title of the Subject Property to Families of Slain Children of Jacksonville, Florida, Inc. at no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), Ordinance Code. A copy of the certificate from the Director of Procurement certifying compliance with provisions of Chapter 122, Ordinance Code, attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this A copy of the property transfer forms is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

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Section 2. Public Purpose. Section 4. Reverter. The disposition authorized herein is conditioned upon Families of Slain Children of Jacksonville, Florida, Inc. using the said vehicle for the purposes set forth

herein and is conditioned upon Families of Slain Children of Jacksonville, Florida, Inc. agreeing to convey the vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not used for those purposes.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization. he Mayor, his designee and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for the surplussing of City personal property between the City of Jacksonville and Families of Slain Children of Jacksonville, Florida, Inc., attached hereto as Exhibit 4, and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
