AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT; APPROPRIATING \$82,850.00 (A \$25,000.00 GRANT FROM THE CHRISTOPHER & DANA REEVE FOUNDATION \$57,850.00 FROM THE ADA FUNDS OF DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES IN FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020) FOR ADAPTIVE KAYAK LAUNCH AT BETHESDA PARK, INITIATED BY B.T. 19-111; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING HIS DESIGNEE, AND COPORATION MAYOR, OR SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE GRANT AWARD LETTER FROM THE CHRISTOPHER & DANA REEVE FOUNDATION; AMENDING THE 2019-2023 FIVE-YEAR IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED CAPITAL BY ORDINANCE 2018-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "BETHESDA PARK - ADAPTIVE KAYAK LAUNCH"; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Bethesda Park - Adaptive Kayak Launch." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in an unnecessary delay in the construction of this recreational infrastructure. Pursuant Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2018-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2018-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Oversight. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
