

1 Introduced by the Council President at the request of the Mayor:  
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4 **ORDINANCE 2019-646**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$110,800 AS  
6 FOLLOWS: (1) \$20,000 FROM THE MAYOR'S  
7 EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY AND \$16,933  
8 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY TO  
9 PROVIDE FUNDING TO THE PUBLIC INFORMATION  
10 CAMPAIGN ON RETENTION PONDS; (2) \$20,000 FROM  
11 THE MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY  
12 AND \$16,934 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING  
13 CONTINGENCY TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO VOLUNTEERS  
14 IN MEDICINE JACKSONVILLE, INC. ("VOLUNTEERS")  
15 TO SERVE PATIENTS IN THE CITY WITHIN THE 32210  
16 ZIP CODE AREA; AND (3) \$20,000 FROM THE  
17 MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY AND  
18 \$16,933 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY  
19 TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF  
20 NORTH FLORIDA, INC. ("GOODWILL") TO SUPPORT  
21 GOODWILL'S ADULT WORKFORCE PREPARATION  
22 PROGRAM, ALL AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-118;  
23 PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL  
24 YEAR 2019-2020; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO  
25 SECTION 126.107(g), *ORDINANCE CODE*; APPROVING  
26 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION  
27 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
28 BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY"),  
29 THE FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH VOLUNTEERS AND  
30 GOODWILL, RESPECTIVELY, TO PARTIALLY FUND THE  
31 FOREGOING PROGRAMS AND SERVICES; REQUESTING

1 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR  
2 OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND  
3 COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,  
7 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
8 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
9 the accounts(s) listed in subsection (b):

11 by this reference)

16 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

17 The funding above is a transfer of surplus funds from the  
18 General Fund/General Services District - Mayor's  
19 Executive Operating Contingency, and from the General  
20 Fund/General Services District- Council Operating  
21 Contingency, to advertising and promotion to provide  
22 funding for a public information campaign on retention  
23 ponds and subsidies and contributions to private sources  
24 to partially fund Volunteers in Medicine Jacksonville,  
25 Inc.'s ("Volunteers") expansion of services in the 32210  
26 zip code to serve an additional patient population and  
27 partially fund Goodwill Industries of North Florida,  
28 Inc.'s ("Goodwill") adult workforce preparation program.

29 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
30 Section 1 is to provide partial funding for Volunteers to be used  
31 for salaries, supplies, and occupancy costs to support the

1 establishment of an office in the 32210 area providing healthcare,  
2 prescriptions and screenings. The appropriation will also provide  
3 funding to Goodwill to fund the establishment of an adult workforce  
4 preparation program in northwest Jacksonville. The appropriation is  
5 also providing funding for a public information campaign related to  
6 retention ponds.

7 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section  
8 1 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
9 year 2019-2020.

10 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g),**  
11 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to enter into an  
12 agreement with each of Volunteers in Medicine Jacksonville, Inc.  
13 and Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc., for each to provide  
14 the services as set forth in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section  
15 126.107(g), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from  
16 competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all  
17 other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code* shall remain in  
18 full force and effect.

19 **Section 5. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby  
20 approved, and the Mayor or his designee and Corporation Secretary  
21 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver: (i) a funding  
22 agreement, including amendments thereto, in accordance with Chapter  
23 118, Parts 1-5, *Ordinance Code*, with Volunteers in Medicine  
24 Jacksonville, Inc. ("Volunteer Agreement") to appropriate \$36,934  
25 to be used for salaries, supplies, and occupancy costs to support  
26 the establishment of an office in the 32210 area providing  
27 healthcare, prescriptions and screenings, as more fully described  
28 in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto; and (ii) a funding agreement, in  
29 accordance with Chapter 118, Parts 1-5, *Ordinance Code*, with  
30 Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. ("Goodwill Agreement")  
31 to appropriate \$36,933 to be used for the establishment of an adult

1 workforce preparation program in northwest Jacksonville. Funding  
2 will be used for candidate assistance, full-time college navigator  
3 position, financial coaching, GED classes and workshops, occupancy,  
4 supplies, and travel as more fully described on **Exhibit 3** attached  
5 hereto.

6 The Mayor or his designee, and Corporation Secretary, are also  
7 authorized to execute additional amendments to each of the  
8 Volunteer Agreement and Goodwill Agreement to amend the City's  
9 maximum indebtedness amount under each agreement in accordance with  
10 such amounts as appropriated by the Council to each agreement in  
11 the annual budget ordinance or separate appropriation ordinances.

12 **Section 6. Requesting one cycle emergency passage**  
13 **pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency  
14 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the  
15 emergency is that the appropriations and funding agreements will be  
16 effective within fiscal year 2018/19 and these funds will otherwise  
17 lapse to the General Fund/General Services District Fund balance as  
18 of September 30, 2019.

19 **Section 7. Oversight.** The Office of Grants and  
20 Compliance shall oversee the two funding agreements described  
21 herein.

22 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
