WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

the Council finds that such rezoning is: WHEREAS, (1)consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds the proposed rezoning does not adversely affect the orderly development of the City as embodied in the Zoning Code; will not adversely affect the health and safety of residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties in the general neighborhood; and will accomplish the objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of the Zoning Code; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (90-684-432) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit medical and office uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following attached documents:

- Exhibit 1 Legal Description dated May 20, 2019.
- Exhibit 2 Subject Property per P&DD.
  - Revised Exhibit 3 Revised Written Description dated September 6, 2019.
  - Revised Exhibit 4 Revised Site Plan dated September 3, 2019.
  - Section 2. Rezoning Approved Subject to Conditions. This rezoning is approved subject to the following conditions. Such conditions control over the Written Description and the Site Plan

and may only be amended through a rezoning.

- (1) On street parking shall be prohibited on Stockton Street from the St. Catherine's entrance to the river.
- (2) Ascension St. Vincent's parking lots shall be utilized by employees, patients, and visitors.
- (3) Employees shall park in Ascension St. Vincent's designated parking lots, which may include remote offsite parking if properly zoned and serviced by shuttle bus.
- (4) Remote offsite parking lots shall provide sufficient parking for the intended use. Any overage shall be redirected to another Ascension St. Vincent's parking lot.
- (5) The City of Jacksonville Planning and Development Department and Riverside Avondale Preservation will be notified if there are changes in the location of a remote offsite parking lot.
- Section 3. Owner and Description. The Subject Property is owned by St. Vincent's Medical Center, Inc., and is legally described in Exhibit 1, attached hereto. The agent is Steve Diebenow, Esq., One Independent Drive, Suite 1200, Jacksonville, Florida 32202; (904) 301-1269.
- Section 4. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall <u>not</u> be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does <u>not</u> approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local

laws.

Section 5. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
