AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN 2010 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WA5EK2A1199839, VEHICLE NUMBER 8103-20) VALUED AT \$4,875, 2010 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EM6A1232110, VEHICLE NUMBER 209-30) VALUED AT \$4,500, 2011 IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974, VEHICLE NUMBER 169-30) VALUED AT \$5,300, 2011 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EM4B1185838, VEHICLE NUMBER 0185-40) VALUED AT \$4,750, 2012 CHEVROLET CAPRICE (VIN 6G1MK5U3XCL638817, VEHICLE NUMBER 1010-30) VALUED AT \$8,325, AND 2012 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5E33C1197441, VEHICLE NUMBER 4797-20) VALUED AT \$4,825 TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE CITY TO TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD, LOCATED AT 1201 ATLANTIC AVENUE, FERNANDINA BEACH, FLORIDA 32034, FOR USE AS PART OF AN ASSIGNED VEHICLE PROGRAM FOR THE NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 122.812(C), ORDINANCE CODE; DESIGNATING THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A REVERTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Declaration of Surplus. Section 1. The City hereby declares that certain 2010 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK2A1199839, vehicle number 8103-20) valued at \$4,875, 2010 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EM6A1232110, vehicle number 209-30) valued at \$4,500, 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974, vehicle number 169-30) valued at \$5,300, 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EM4B1185838, vehicle number 0185-40) valued at \$4,750, 2012 Chevrolet Caprice (VIN 6G1MK5U3XCL638817, vehicle number 1010-30) valued at \$8,325, and 2012 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5E33C1197441, vehicle number 4797-20) valued at \$4,825, as more particularly described in Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Subject Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City officials to transfer title of the Subject Property to Nassau County School Board, located at 1201 Atlantic Avenue, Fernandina Beach, Florida 32034, at no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), Ordinance Code. A copy of the certificate from the Chief of Procurement certifying compliance with provisions of Chapter 122, Ordinance Code, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the property transfer forms is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 2. Public Purpose. The surplus vehicle is needed by the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police. The City of Jacksonville finds that providing the surplussed vehicle to the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police is a valid public purpose.

Section 3. Fleet Management Division to Monitor Actual Use of Subject Property. The Fleet Management Division of the

Finance and Administration Department will be the designated agency to monitor the Nassau County School Board's use of the Subject Property in accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

Section 4. Reverter. The disposition authorized herein is conditioned upon the Nassau County School Board using the said vehicle for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned upon the Nassau County School Board agreeing to convey the vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not used for those purposes.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
